

CONDITIONS

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM & FEE

There is a limit of 2 pieces per artist. Intending exhibitors are required to complete the application form and submit this together with the following information for each work by **8 October, 2010.**

- **A print ready digital image/ photograph or drawing of the piece to be exhibited (Digital images may be used for promotional purposes for the BDAS in the future.)**
- **Materials used and type of construction.**
- **Dimensions.**
- **Time span of installation and any requirements of installation.**
- **Brief general comments about the work (no more than 200 words)**

SELECTION

Sculptural works will need to be of appropriate construction so as to not pose any risk to the safety of the public. The Selection Committee will consider all applications and their decision on works accepted will be final.

SITES

Exhibitors should familiarise themselves if possible with the BDAS site including garden areas and may wish to indicate a preferred location for their exhibit. If exhibitors wish to construct a sculpture for a particular site they are advised to contact the BDAS office by phone on 02 48614093 or email: b.d.a.s@bigpond.com

A plan of the BDAS site with approximate dimensions is included.

INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL FROM SITE

Installation will take place on Sat 23 Oct, 9am – 2pm

Removal will take place on Sun 21 Nov, 9am – 2pm

All exhibitors will be responsible for the transport of their work to and from the BDAS grounds. Exhibitors are responsible for all costs associated with manufacture, freight, installation, and insurance of the works. BDAS will supply Public Liability Insurance cover for the works.

Exhibiting artists will be responsible for the installation and dismantling of their sculptures. If any proposed exhibit would require special equipment to put it in place or any special fixing, the BDAS office should be consulted at the earliest stage to see if this is feasible.

SALES

Exhibiting artists are invited to price their work for sale. A **commission of 25%** including GST, will be charged on all work sold during the exhibition. Artists need to provide a laminated sign that can be secured at the site with the sculptural work that shows the artists name, title of work, price of work and any accompanying comments the artist would like to add. The size of the sign should be compatible with the work exhibited and its site.

LIABILITY

The BDAS committee accepts no responsibility for damage to exhibits from any cause. It reserves the right to refuse entry to, or to remove, any exhibit which might be a public danger. Exhibitors are responsible for all costs associated with insurance of their works.

ENTRY FEE

\$25 for non-members and \$15 for members.

A cheque or postal order, payable to BDAS, must accompany the application.

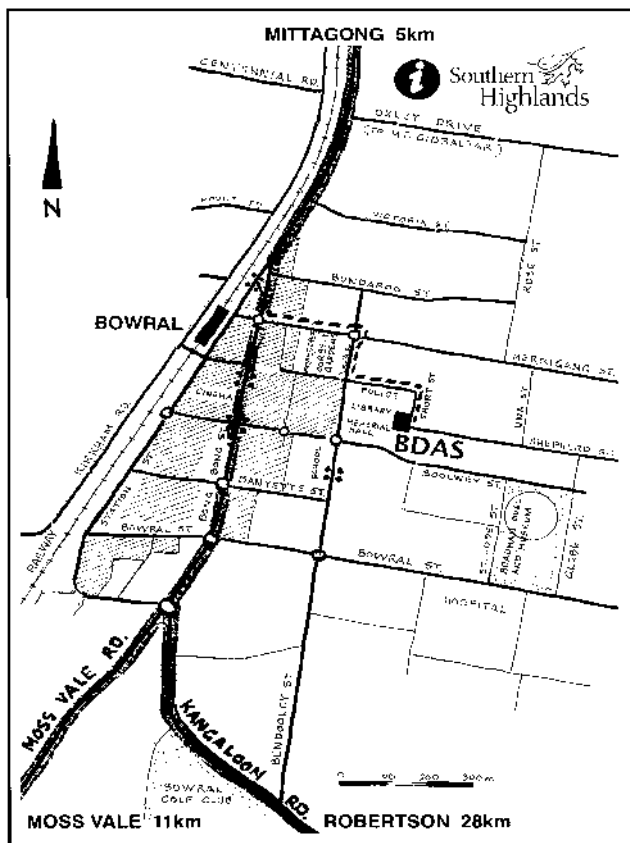

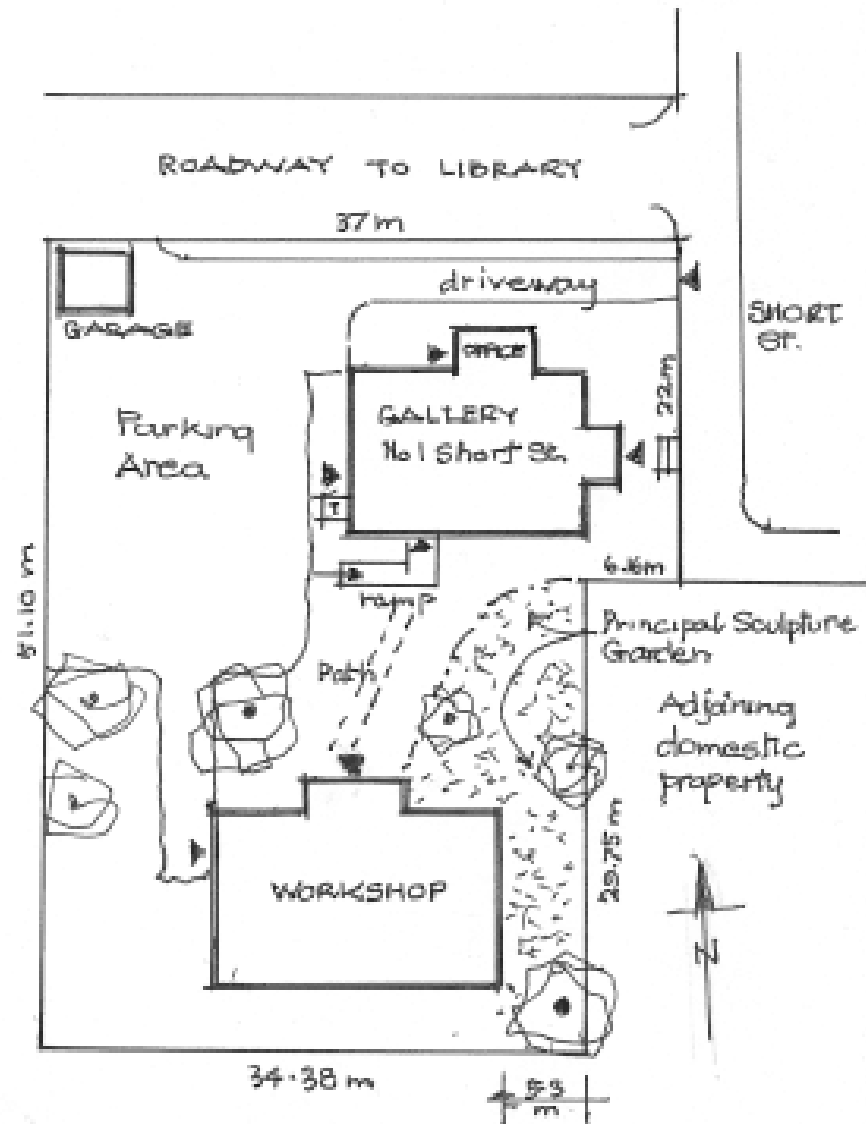
