CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Landscape works are the personal interpretation of the artist predominantly of the natural world but inclusive of the built environment. Works may be realistic or abstract. The work must be an original signed drawing, painting or of a print-making medium, or a 3D work excluding photography or reproductions; not previously shown with this society, and completed in the past 12 months. There is a limit of two works per artist. All works must be for sale.

The Judge and Curator will view all entries and their decision on work to be exhibited and prizes awarded will be final. The BDAS do not pre-judge works by digital image. There is no guarantee that all entries will be hung.

The artist warrants that they are the original author of the work. Furthermore, the work does not, to the best of the artist's knowledge, infringe the copyright or moral rights of any third party.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRY FORM & FEE

Exhibitors are required to complete the application form and submit this with the appropriate fee, to the BDAS office by 4pm on 17 April 2024. Entry forms can be emailed. Entry fees are non-refundable.

Members \$25 per work, Non-members \$35 per work

Payment of entry fees may be by cash, by credit card, by cheque, made payable to BDAS and posted or emailed to Bowral & District Art Society, PO Box 144, BOWRAL, NSW 2576. There is also a locked box outside the office for entries. PREPARATION OF WORKS

Note: Bowral Art gallery reserves the right to reject any work which does not comply with all conditions.

- Works must not exceed 1.25 m Width x 1.8 m Height on outside measurement of frame, and are subject to a maximum weight restriction of 12kg
- All works must either be framed, on a board or a stretched gallery canvas.
- Works must be suitably prepared for hanging, with 2 D-rings 5-15cm from top of work. D-rings must be free of wire or cords.
- o If necessary, a 2nd set of D-rings should be attached to the work.
- A label showing: Name of Artist, Title, & Price is to be attached to the back of the work.
- A second label with the same details, is to be attached by string to hang just below the lower edge the art work (for cataloguing purposes).
- Please make sure all your details are correct.
