Spend an exciting weekend exploring light with the beautiful medium of transparent watercolour. Using a range of subject matter from Still life and landscape, students will learn to render the light of different times of day, as well as indoor and outdoor effects. The workshop begins with structured exercises in colour

mixing and managing tone, working mostly from life and direct observation. We learn to paint the changing colour of shadows and how to describe light on different surfaces, such as glass, foliage and rocks. We will practice both wet and dry techniques to describe the mood and atmosphere of different light situations. By the end of the workshop students will have completed two small longer paintings on subject matter of their choice. Tanya encourages individual styles and will work with students to develop their own ideas. Beginners and more experienced artists are welcome.
