Overview

This workshop is open to all levels, from beginners to experienced painters. We all have something to learn, and just as importantly, ideas to share.

What the Workshop Will Involve

- Guided still life painting sessions
- Focus on observation (“learning to see”), composition, colour, and paint handling
- A shared still life setup for the group to interpret
- Option to introduce a second setup on Day 2 if appropriate

Approach

I'm interested in what *you* see in the still life. We'll explore drawing and composition, and gently challenge familiar habits. Many participants at BDAS may already have an established style—this workshop offers an opportunity to experiment and try new approaches.

Where helpful, I can introduce references to other artists whose work may inspire and support your direction.

For Beginners

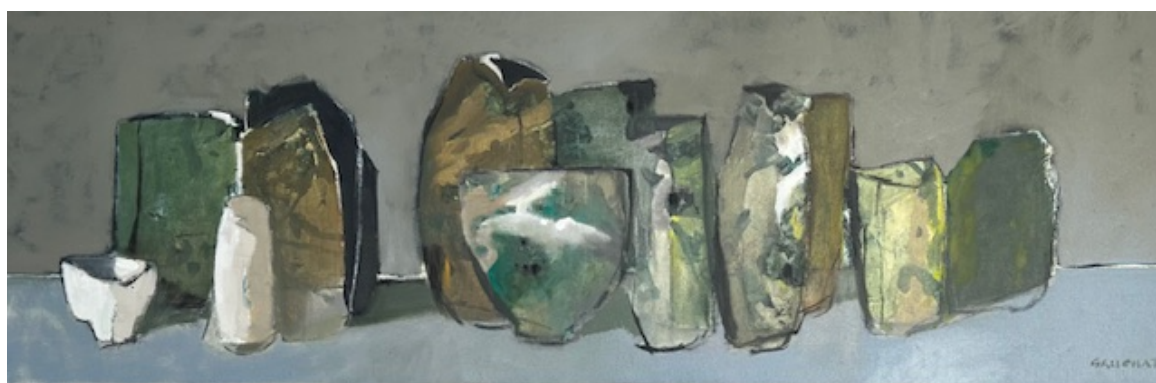
If you're newer to painting, this is a supportive environment. I encourage you to move beyond hesitation and embrace the idea that *all is possible*—because it is.

Method

- Begin with small sketches to explore composition and ideas
- Develop your chosen approach on canvas
- Work in acrylics, allowing flexibility—changes can be made quickly and confidently
