Her philosophy is 'There are no mistakes, when something doesn't quite work out as planned let the painting guide you on what needs doing and let it evolve in its own way'

Kate Vella has been running workshops and exhibiting since 2019, since her first solo show Antidote in Sydney, she continues to exhibit at Michael Reid Galleries and collaborates in various art events. She was awarded first prize in The Agency Bowral Still Life Prize 2022, and is a finalist in numerous awards among these are Ravenswood Australian Women's Art Prize 2020 and 2022 and KAAF Korean and Australian Foundation Art Prize 2025.

Her work is held in private collections in Australia and Internationally, and at the Osborn House Boutique Hotel in the Southern Highlands. She featured on the cover of Country Style magazine, in The Highlife magazine and in Home Beautiful.

In 2025 she was one of the four artists in The Celebrity Portrait Reveal Fundraiser and continues to take part in numerous charity and Fundraising events for important causes and is a volunteer at our Regional Gallery Ngununggula.
