

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

“Works of art made using the medium of watercolour - a water soluble paint with transparent properties”. (Tate)

The work must be an original signed painting, either entirely using watercolour paint, or using mixed media where watercolour paint is the dominant medium; on paper or on watercolour primed canvas or board; not previously shown with this society, and completed in the past 12 months. Reproductions of work will not be accepted. There is a limit of two works by the artist. All works must be for sale.

The Judge and Curator will view all entries and their decision on work to be exhibited and prizes awarded will be final. There is no guarantee that all entries will be hung.

The artist warrants that they are the original author of the work. Furthermore, the work does not, to the best of the artist's knowledge, infringe the copyright or moral rights of any third party.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRY FORM & FEE

Members \$25 per work, Non-members \$35 per work

Exhibitors are required to complete the application form and submit this with the appropriate fee, to the BDAS office by 4pm on 6th September 2023.

Entry fees are non-refundable.

Payment of entry fees may be by cash, bank transfer, credit card, or cheque made payable to BDAS and posted to Bowral & District Art Society, PO Box 144, BOWRAL, NSW 2576. There is a locked box outside the office for entries.

For payment via bank transfer, please ensure your name is noted on the internet transfer instructions and the date of payment noted on the entry form.

SIZE & FRAMING

- Works must not exceed **1.25 m Width x 1.8 m Height** on outside measurement of frame, and are subject to a maximum weight restriction of 15kg
- All 2D works must either be framed, on a board or on a gallery canvas.
- Works must be suitably prepared for hanging, with 2 D-rings 5-15cm from top of work. Please keep D Rings free of wire or cord.
- A label showing: Name of Artist, Title, & Price is to be attached to the back of the work **and duplicated on a second label attached by string to hang down below the art work** (for cataloguing purposes).

SALES & COMMISSION

A commission of 30% will be charged on all work sold. At the completion of the exhibition, the artist will be remitted the balance of the sale, less a further 1.5% EFTPOS surcharge (*where applicable) within 14 days by bank transfer.
