In this one day workshop, Susan will guide her students to create their own beautiful paper which can be used for stationery, made into journals or a host of lovely projects such as bowls and paper lights. There is so much to create when you recycle and make handmade paper.

- At this workshop, you will make handmade paper, adding flowers, raw cotton, and colours to make beautiful stationery. You will learn how to prepare your pulp, pull sheets of paper, add seeds for gift tags, or try embossing the wet paper.
- You will also learn how to stitch a hardcover journal that you will make from start to finish using Coptic Stitching
- Sculpt a bowl
- Make translucent papers for lights
